

## School Board Communication Strategies

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### Introduction

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One step to developing a strong relationship between the school and Local Educational Agency is regular communication with the school board about fidelity and outcomes related to SWIFT features.

### Communication Strategies

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The following are examples of strategies schools can use to keep school board members informed about SWIFT implementation.
